

The Rock is a fully integrated mixed use development of 1.6million square feet, aimed at regenerating the town centre of Bury. The £350million project by Hammerson includes 60 shops, 8 restaurants, 1,250 parking spaces and 408 residential units.

Lang+Fulton (formerly Orsogrill UK) supplied 300m² of custom-sized panels together with 20 sets of doors to secure and ventilate the street-front elevations of the electricity substations. These were made to fit the structural openings with concealed ancillary steelwork. **Louvre Talia-100** steel louvred material was chosen for its vandal-resistant properties, in particular that it was impenetrable to any abuse from a foreign object.

2.8m high **Louvre Talia-80** was also used in the car park to create an internal visual screen separating the vehicle access from a service road. In addition 160m of 2.8m high **63x132mm (Sterope)** grating panels were installed on the upper levels of the car park to secure plant areas and emergency exits.
